Appeal for Prison Ministry

The revolution in Egypt has brought about many changes in our country. One that affects our Prison Ministry is changes to the prison system relating to foreigners imprisoned in Egypt. In the past, we knew of cases of prisoners serving their 20 year sentence, and then having to stay in prison for another 5 years because they couldn't afford the large sum of money the authorities demanded from them.

This change means that six of the men who have been in prison for a long time will be released. These men are all involved in the Kanater Men's Prison Christian Fellowship, a group which was started by the men in the prison. One of the leaders of the fellowship who has been granted clemency says;

“Join us in praising God for the marvellous work he has done for us.
At last we can now smell freedom.”

These men are now able to return home to their homes and their families. However, they are not able to pay for their air ticket. Please consider helping us to meet this need.
